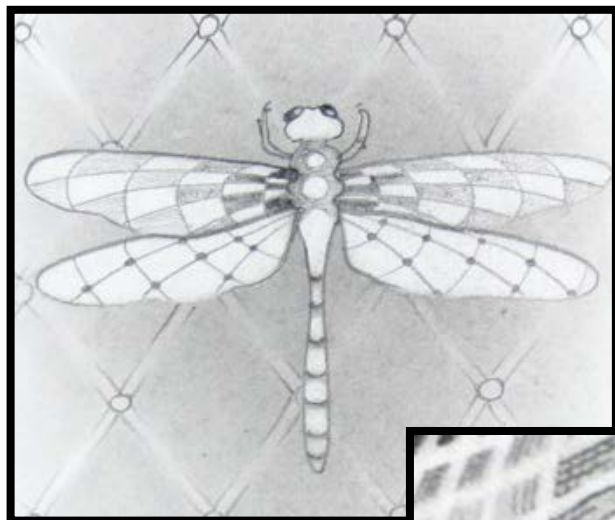

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Zero Drawing

Zero Drawing is a new technique that uses Tombow's **MONO Drawing Pencils** along with erasers. The high-quality precision **MONO Zero Erasers** feature two shapes and sizes; Round 2.3 mm and Rectangle 2.5 mm. They are refillable and easy to use and store with the pen-style body. The **MONO NP Eraser** offers clean erasing with environmentally free 100% recycled sleeve and non-PVC materials.



The **Zero Drawing Technique** starts with laying down a light graphite field, and then erasing with a subtractive design with the erasers. Pencil strokes and shading are then added to create this unusual and beautiful effect. Perfect for creating Zentangle-inspired effects!

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
