


How to watercolor a: Peony



step 1:



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
- paint three petals within an imaginary circle. Paint two petals on the outside.

↓ PRACTICE SPACE:



step 2:

- layer a darker shade on the tops and bottoms of the petals.
- Blend the colors with water.



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

step 3:

- paint leaves in a broad stroke, coming to a point.

step 4:

- when dry, use MONO Drawing Pens to add details and directional lines.

How to watercolor a Gerbera Daisy



Step 1:

- paint small lines in upward strokes.

↓ PRACTICE SPACE:



Step 2:

- layer a darker shade in the middle.
- layer a brighter shade on outer petals.




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
Step 3:

- paint two broad lines that meet, to create leaves.

Step 4:

- when dry, use MoNo Drawing Pens to add details and directional lines.

How to watercolor a Tulip



Step 1:

- Paint long ovals with a light yellow in a loose heart shape.

↓ PRACTICE SPACE:



Step 2:

- fill gap with a darker shade and paint small hills on top.



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
Step 3:

- blend dark green on the base of each flower for stems.
- paint long curved strokes for leaves.

Step 4:

- when dry, use MONO Drawing Pens to add details and directional lines.

How to watercolor a Water Lily




- paint long upward strokes to create petals.

↓ PRACTICE SPACE:




Step 2:

- layer the darker color for outer petals



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Step 3:

- once dry, add outermost petals in a purple color
- to create leaves, paint a triangle shape on the bottom of the flower.

Step 4:

- when dry, use MONO Drawing Pens to add details and directional lines.
